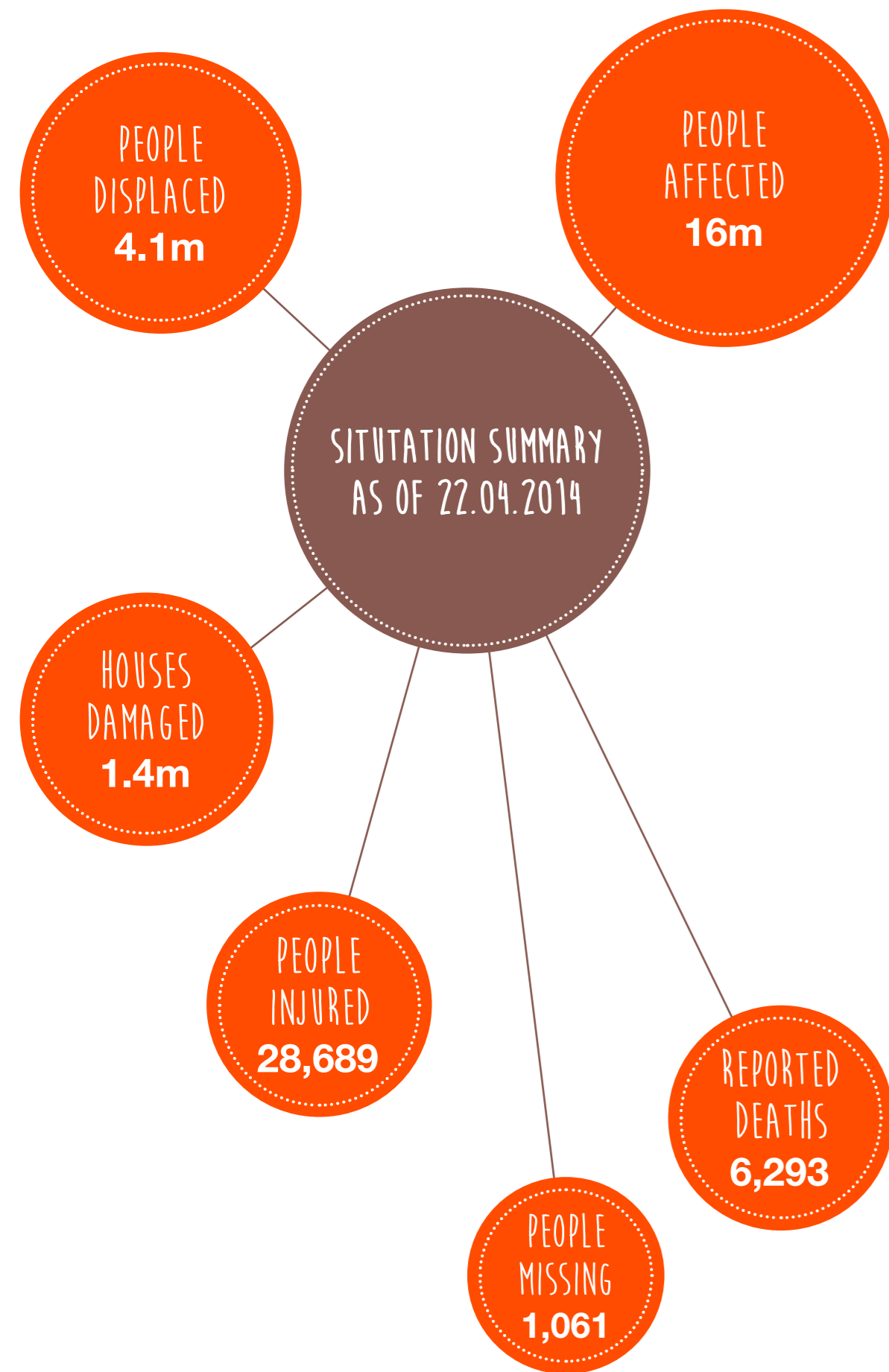

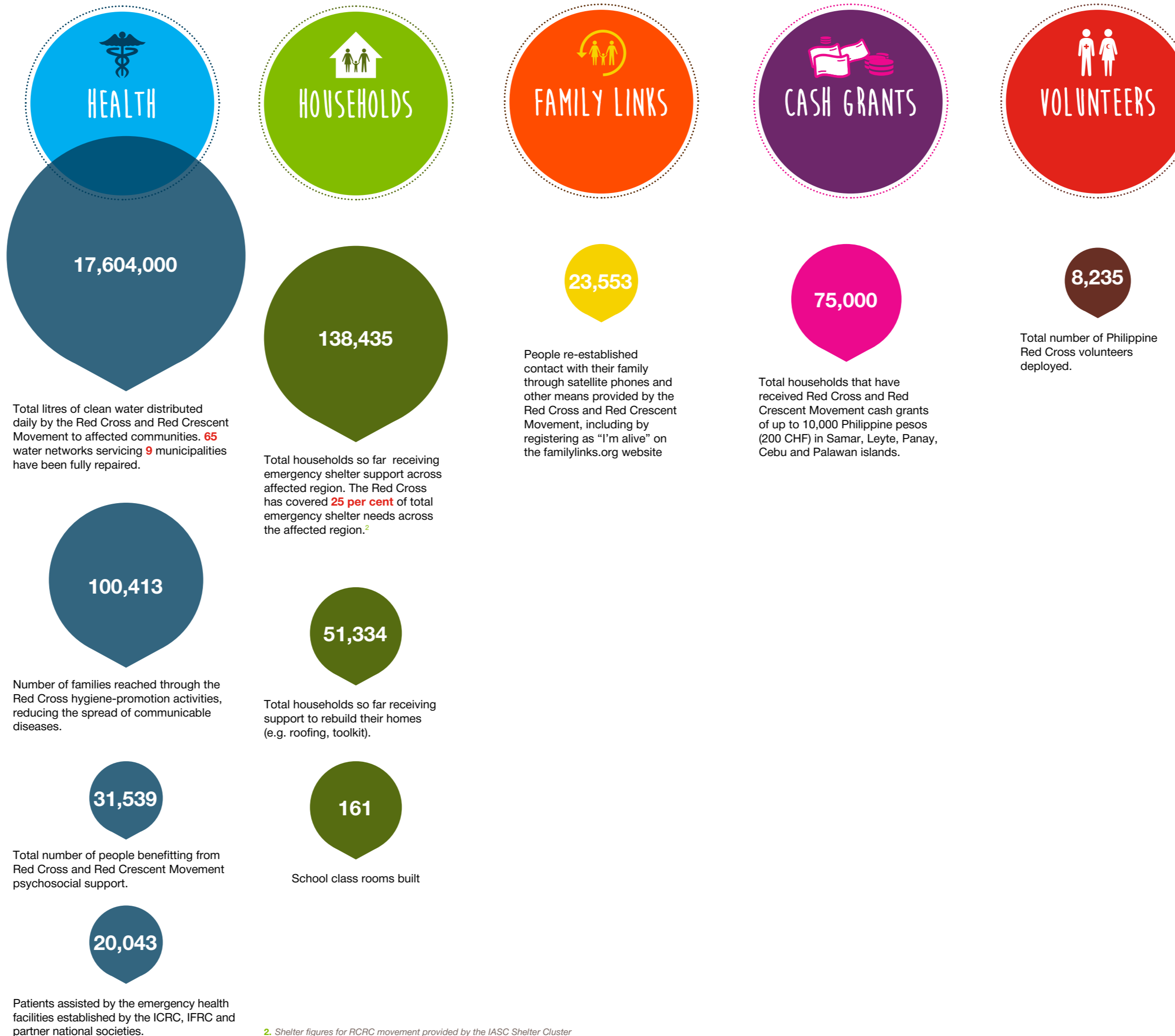

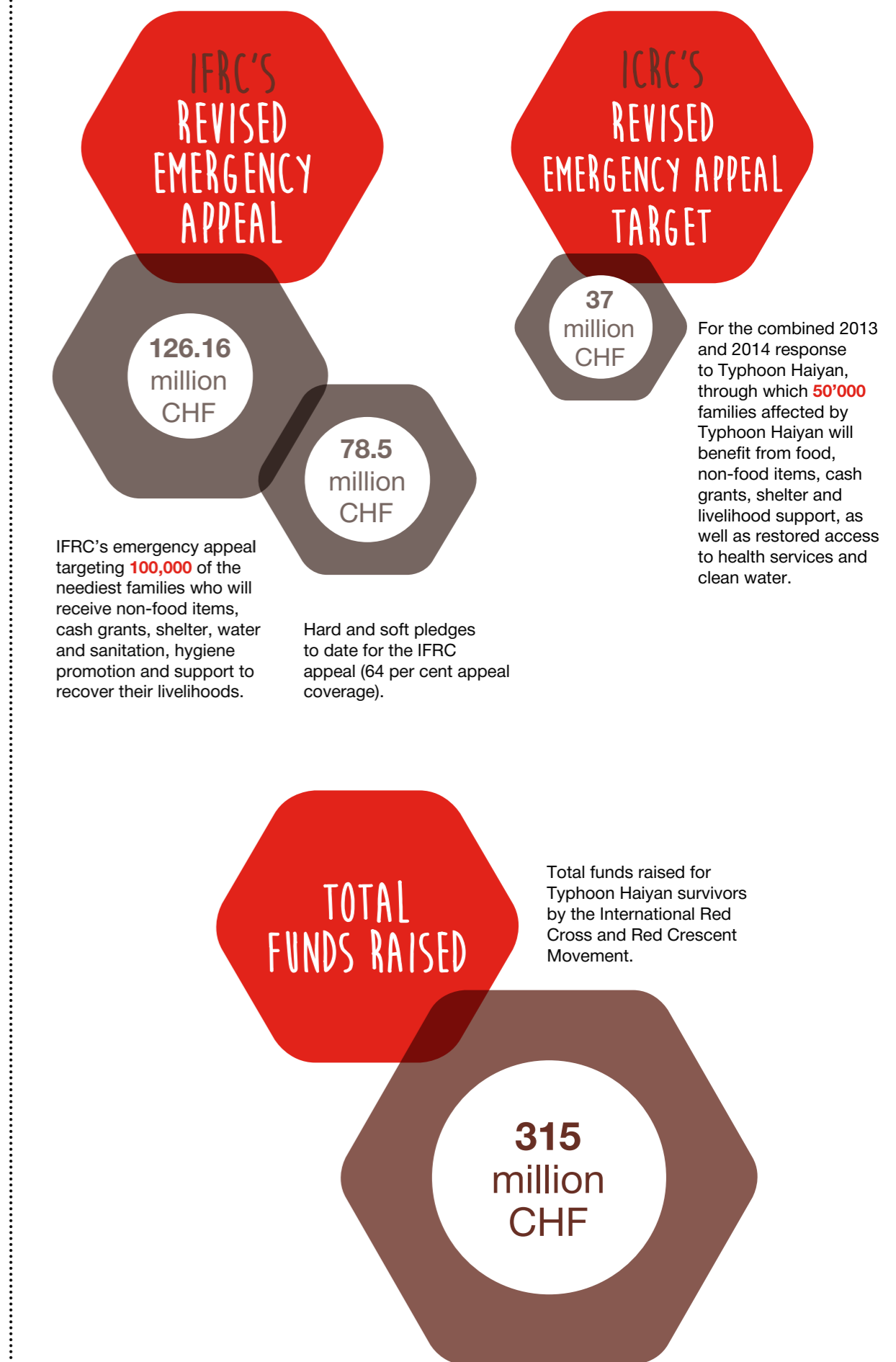
Red Cross response to date
