The ICRC office in Gaza is looking for candidates to fill in the following position:

#### Main Tasks:

- Ensure waste is disposed in correct waste stream
- Dispose of waste in a safe manner according to IPC plan, including operation of incinerator units and disposal of ash
- Use, maintain and troubleshoot waste incinerators, placenta pit and ash pits
- Ensure general litter is controlled on the FH site and adjacent waste management site.
- Ensure waste collection and storage areas are regularly cleaned and maintained
- Ensure vermin and insect control plan is developed
- Ensure site is inspected for signs of vermin and insect infestations
- Ensure vermin and insect controls are implemented and maintained (e.g. rodent trapping, emptying/treating vector breeding sites, residual chemical treatments).

  - Maintenance of tents
  - Maintenance of technical equipment such as air conditioners, heaters, pumps, and other electrical and mechanical equipment/facilities
  - Support on general construction worksShift work and on-call work can be expected.
