The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) is an impartial, neutral, and independent organization whose exclusively humanitarian mission is to protect the lives and dignity of victims of war and internal violence and to provide them with assistance. It also endeavors to prevent suffering by promoting and strengthening humanitarian law and universal humanitarian principles.

The ICRC office in Gaza is looking for candidates to fill in the following position:

Function : Maintenance Technician - WASH (Field Hospital)

Place of employment : Gaza - Rafah

Occupation rate : Full time

Type of Contract : Temporary

Expected Starting Date : ASAP

Main Tasks:

- Daily water production using reverse osmosis systems
- Maintain 48 hours of raw water and treated water for the hospital supply
- Ensure fire safety tank and pump are regularly tested and ready for use
- Oversee, maintenance of reverse osmosis units as per maintenance plan and on demand
- Monitoring and logging of key water quality parameters including residual chlorine, E. coli bacteria and nitrate/nitrite in the water supply network
- Troubleshooting problems, e.g. pump leakage, bad water quality results
- Adjustment of chlorination based on controls and desired targets
- Logging water production and consumption
- Oversee maintenance of piped network (drinking water and sewage), pumps, mobile handwashing stations and tanks/bladders.
- Coordinate emergency response (e.g. temporary water supply and sewage) as a result of system failures or loss of raw water sources
- Monitoring camp for general hygiene and sanitation concerns
- Liaison with WATHAB engineer on production and supply issues



- Oversee maintenance of WASH facilities and liaison with cleaning team leader on cleaning and waste management
- Liaise with FH public health team during outbreak responses, and for general hygiene interventions (e.g. staff and client hygiene promotion)

Education and professional experience requirements:

- University degree/Diploma in a related field.
- The positions will be part of the general hospital maintenance crew. Technical works necessary at the hospital, outside of the job description must be expected.
 Experience with setting up and maintaining field hospitals will be highly regarded.
 Experience with ICRC operations will be well regarded. General tasks will include, but is not limited to:
- Maintenance of tents
- Maintenance of technical equipment such as air conditioners, heaters, pumps, and other electrical and mechanical equipment/facilities
- Support on general construction works
 Shift work and on-call work can be expected.

Interested candidates fulfilling the above criteria should send the following:

- A detailed C.V. in English.
- Copy of the highest academic degree obtained and relevant work certificates.
