The ICRC office in Gaza is looking for candidates to fill in the following position:

Function : **Laboratory Technician (Field Hospital)**

Place of employment : **Gaza - Rafah**

Occupation rate : **Full time**

Type of Contract : **Temporary**

Expected Starting Date : **ASAP**

Main Tasks:

- Provides laboratory services and blood transfusion services and applies quality control measures.
- Support and train MoH laboratory technicians on ICRC laboratory protocols.
- Ensures optimal safety measures (for patients, donors, and health personnel, including medical waste management, applies and promote hygiene standards.
- Prepares orders for medical supplies and identifies needs for laboratory equipment and consumables.
- Contributes to reporting.

Education and professional experience requirements:

- University degree in a related field.
- Certified laboratory technician.
- Fluent command of English.
- Computer proficiency.

- 3 years of professional experience in hospital setting required and up-to-date knowledge.
- Experience in limited resources settings and/or humanitarian organizations.
